ORDER:

The Hon'ble Minister for Health and Family Welfare has made the following announcement (Announcement No.6) on the floor of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly while moving the Demand No.19 of the Health and Family Welfare Department on 18.04.2023.

2. In the letter read above, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has stated that the Tamil Nadu Accident and Emergency care Initiative (TAEI) Program has been launched in 2017 in order to strengthen the trauma and emergency care and at present 94 Government health facilities are functioning as TAEI facilities. These Tamil Nadu Accident and Emergency care Initiative (TAEI) centers are dealing with 6 pillars, namely Trauma, MI, Stroke, Poison, Burns Paediatric Emergencies and other life-threatening conditions. As a front-line face lifting unit in institution, these centers play a major role in quality management and bring down the mortality. Further, gap analysis are being done regularly to identify new centers in the state to upgrade as a Tamil Nadu Accident and Emergency care Initiative (TAEI) Centre with the provision of Infrastructures (Civil Modifications, Equipments, etc.,).

3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has stated that Government Hospital, Chengam, Tiruvannamali District is one among them identified for upgradation as Tamil Nadu Accident and Emergency care Initiative (TAEI) Centre. The Government Hospital, Chengam is covering 1,80,000 population within the town and from surrounding areas. Since, the population is continuously raising and also the need for medical care to the poor people is high, there is need to improve the medical health care facilities of the sub district hospital, Chengam in

Tiruvannamalai District. Any emergency cases including Trauma from within the town and from the surrounding areas are reported to this centre, as it is located strategically. Due to lack of infrastructure, the cases are being shifted to the Medical College which takes the travelling time of more than one hour which lead to losing the advantage of Golden hour to save the life. He has further stated that this proposal was approved by the State Empowered Committee. Hence, he has requested to sanction Rs.3,50,00,000/- (Rupees Three Crore and Fifty Lakh only) for construction of new TAEI building in the Government Hospital, Chengam, Tiruvannamalai District as a Tamil Nadu Accident and Emergency care Initiative (TAEI) center.

4. Further, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has stated that the Engineer-in-Chief, Public Works Department has informed that out of the amount of Rs.3,50,00,000/- a sum of Rs.90,00,000/- required for this year 2023-2024 and the remaining amount of Rs.2,60,00,000/- for next Financial year 2024-2025.

5. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program and accord an administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.3,50,00,000/- (Rupees three crore ad fifty lakh only) for strengthening of Government Hospital Chengam, Tiruvannamalai District as a Tamil Nadu Accident and Emergency care Initiative (TAEI) Centre towards execution of the civil works through Public Works Department as detailed below:-

6. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 5 above shall be debited under the following Head of account:-

"4210 – Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 01 Urban Health Services - 200 Other Health Schemes – Externally Aided Projects – PD, Tamil Nadu Health System Reforms Project – Administrated by Director of Medical and Rural Health Services - 416 - Major works – 01 Major works."

(IFHRMS DPC 4210 - 01-200 - PD-41601).

7. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is authorized to draw and disburse the expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 5 above and follow the conditions stipulated in the Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program (TNHSRP) guidelines.

8. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is directed to maintain a separate account exclusively for Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program (TNHSRP) funds in Directorate, which should be operated by Joint Signatory.

9. Necessary funds of Rs.90,00,000/- will be provided in Revised Estimate/ Final Modified Appropriation 2023-2024. Pending provision of such funds, the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is authorized to draw and disburse the above sanctioned amount. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2023-2024. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is also requested to include this

expenditure while sending the budget proposals for Revised Estimate/ Final Modified Appropriation 2023-2024 and also send draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2023-2024 to Government in Finance (BG-I/Health-II) Department at an appropriate time without fail.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide e-File No.3802/2023, dated:06.01.2024 and ASL No.1677 (One thousand six hundred and seventy seven). (IFHRMS ASL No.2024011677).
