ORDER:-

During the Collectors and Police Officers Conference held from 05.03.2018 to 07.03.2018 the Hon'ble Chief Minister has announced the following announcement:-

'அரிது அரிது மானிடராய் பிறத்தல் அரிது' என்ற ஒளவையாரின் வாக்கின்படி, அரிய மனித உயிர்களை விபத்திலிருந்து காக்கும் உன்னதமான சேவையில் அதிக ஈடுபாட்டோடு செயல்படும் முதல் மூன்று மாவட்டங்கள் மற்றும் ஒரு மாநகரத்திற்கு ஆண்டுதோறும் "தமிழ்நாடு முதலமைச்சரின் விபத்து குறைப்பிற்கான சிறந்த மாவட்டம் மற்றும் சிறந்த நகரத்திற்கான விருது" வழங்கப்படும்.

- 2. In pursuance of the above announcement the Transport Commissioner has sent the proposal and has stated that three best Districts and one Commissioner of Police will be given an award every year for having reduced the number of road accidents and consequent deaths. He has further stated that in order to decide the eligibility or otherwise for receipt of award, the following executive committee may be formed:-
 - 1. Secretary to Government, Home, Chairman Prohibition and Excise Department
 - 2. Additional Director General of Police Member (Traffic & Road Safety)

- 3. Director General, Highways Department - Member
- 4. Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Member System Project
- 5. Mission Director, National Health Mission Member & Ex-officio Commissioner of Trauma Care
- 6. Transport Commissioner - Member Secretary

The above mentioned committee will convene the meeting and decide the eligibility for the award.

- 3. The Transport Commissioner has also furnished the details of eligibility criteria for selection and award details. In view of the above, he has requested the Government to issue necessary orders in this
- 4. The Government have examined the proposal of the Transport Commissioner and decided to accept the same. Accordingly, the Government constitute the following executive committee to decide the eligibility for receipt of award for best three districts and one Commissioner of Police for having reduced the road accidents and consequent deaths.
 - 1. Secretary to Government, Home, - Chairman Prohibition and Excise Department
 - 2. Additional Director General of Police (Traffic Member & Road Safety)
 - 3. Director General, Highways Department - Member
 - 4. Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Member Project
 - 5. Mission Director, National Health Mission & Member Ex-officio Commissioner of Trauma Care
 - 6. Transport Commissioner Member Secretary
 - 5. The Government also direct as follows:-
- (i) The Committee constituted in para 4 above will convene a meeting and decide the eligibility for the award. While deciding the eligibility the following criteria will be taken into account for selection:-
 - Reduction of road accidents and consequent deaths 1. in the Districts and City.

- 2. Convening of meeting of District Road Safety Committee.
- 3. Utilization of Road Safety Fund.
- 4. Road Safety Awareness creation.
- 5. Distribution of Chief Minister's Accident Relief Fund.
- 6. Mobilization of CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility) fund as other activities for Road Safety.
- 7. Number of over speeding, over loading passengers in goods vehicle and drunken driving cases booked.
- 8. Number of cases booked for without helmet, using of mobile phone while driving.
- 9. Reduction of unauthorised cuts on the National Highways Authority of India roads.
- Identification and rectification of black spots by National Highways Authority of India and National Highways roads.
- 11. Road signage/speed limit signage in National Highways Authority of India roads.
- 12. Maintain and data feedings in Road Accident Data Management System.
- 13. Any other criteria decided by the Committee.
- (ii) The following award will be given to the best three Districts and one Commissioner of Police:-

Best Districts with shield

 1^{st} Prize = 25 Lakhs

 2^{nd} Prize = 13 Lakhs

 3^{rd} Prize = 10 Lakhs

Commissioner of Police

Rs.15 Lakhs with shield

(iii) The award money will be paid from the State Road Safety Fund to the District Road Safety Committee for spending this cash award in road safety work in the districts/City by Collectors and Commissioner of Police.
