ORDER:

The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has informed that Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program is a World Bank supported project implemented by Department of Health and Family Welfare (DoH&FW) of Tamil Nadu Government on Program for Results (P for R) basis. The program claims at achieving SDG 3 target by ensuring health lives and promising wellbeing for all at all ages in Tamil Nadu. The total budget of the program is 287 million US\$ over a period of 5 years which will supplement the overall budget of Government of Tamil Nadu in health department of 4,990 million US\$ in next 5 years to achieve the results. The loan agreement was signed on 04.06.2019 and the effectiveness date is declared as 29.07.2019. In the Government Order first read above, the Administrative Sanction of the project was accorded. The Goal of the Project is to improve quality of care, strengthen management of non-communicable diseases and injuries, and reduce inequities in reproductive and child health services in Tamil Nadu. The project is being implemented and the first-year activity carried out from July 2019 to March 2020. In first year, all the disbursement linked results were achieved and disbursement claimed to the World Bank of USD 5,20,23,500 and the budget allotted for the first year activity was sanctioned in the Government Order second read above.

2. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has forwarded the proposal approved by the State Empowered Committee headed by the Chief Secretary to establish Trauma Registry and Information Technology Platform in 26 Centres and to sanction an amount of Rs.1.17 Crores (Rupees One crore seventeen lakh only) in the second year activities of Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program as detailed below:

It is essential to have concrete data on the pre-hospital, hospital management and disposition of all trauma cases for analysis and improvement of trauma care services. Comprehensive trauma and other emergency related data are not available at Hospital/District/State level. It was proposed to develop a comprehensive Trauma Registry and Implement it in 27 centers (all existing Government Medical college Hospitals and 2 attached institutions namely Institute of Child Health, Egmore and Government Hospital, Royapettah are covered) [The institutions are listed and annexed to this Government Order]

The State Empowered Committee in its meeting held on 03.08.2020 has approved the proposal for the implementation of Trauma Registry in 26 more centres (1 Centre Vellore was established as 1st year activity), with a budget allocation of Rs.1.17 crores - Rs.1.07 crores to the Directorate of Medical Education for establishment of Trauma Registry in 26 centres and to allow the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program to utilize Rs.10,00,000 towards the establishment of Information Technology (IT) platform for Trauma registry, any software developed shall be opened and owned by the State. (Detailed Budget is annexed to this Government Order)

The registry should be inclusive of the data available in Road Accident Data Management System (RADMS), 108 services and may be linked with HMIS in a later date. As part of Registry component 2 posts of Trauma Registry Assistant to each centre (Total of 54 posts) may be sanctioned. Trauma Registry Assistant: Appointed by outsourcing.

Qualification: He/ She should have completed Diploma / Degree in Nursing with Computer knowledge.

Job functions:

1. He/ She will collect and enter the relevant registry data from time of incidence, Pre hospital in hospital course till disposal of the patient.
2. He/ She will collate and analyze the data for the given indicators periodically in co-ordination with the institutional authorities and also with the State registry team.
3. He/ She will compile and collate trauma related data from other sources like RADMS, 108 EMS, etc.
4. He/ She will also assist in nursing related work in Emergency Department-relevant to trauma registry activities.

3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has stated that in respect of certain activities, the activities are to be implemented by the respective directorates with the budget being sanctioned under their respective heads under Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program and requested the Government to issue necessary orders to establish Trauma Registry and Information Technology Platform in 26 Centres and to sanction an amount of Rs.1.17 Crores

(Rupees One crore seventeen lakh only) in the second year activities of Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program.

4. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program have decided to accept the same and issue following orders:-

- i) The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program is permitted to implement Trauma Registry in 26 centres as detailed in annexure annexed to this Government Order.
- ii) Sanction is accorded for an amount of Rs.1.07 Crore to the Director of Medical Education for establishment of Trauma Registry in 26 centres as detailed in annexure annexed to this Government Order.
- iii) The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program is permitted to utilize Rs.10 lakh towards the establishment of Information Technology (IT) platform for Trauma registry, any software developed shall be opened and owned by the State as detailed in annexure annexed to this Government Order.
- iv) The registry should be inclusive of the data available in Road Accident Data Management System (RADMS), 108 services and to link with HMIS in a later date.
- v) The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program is permitted to sanction two post of Trauma Registry Assistant to each centre through outsourcing (Total 27 X 2 = 54) (26 + 1 established in Vellore in first year activity). The qualification and job functions as detailed in annexure annexed to this Government Order.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 (ii) above, shall be debited to the following head of account:-
