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## **ORDER:**

The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program in the letter read above, has stated that the Regional Institute of Ophthalmology, Government Ophthalmic Hospital, Chennai is the oldest and renowned Ophthalmic Institute in Southeast Asia which was established in the year 1819. The Hospital consists of various Speciality Departments like Glaucoma Department, Cornea Department, Retina Department, the Strabismology, Paediatric, Squint and Neuro-Ophthalmology, Orbit and Oculoplasty etc., which provides high quality specialized eye care to the poor and needy patients. The hospital has a highly active eye bank which performs 250 to 300 corneal transplants every year. It is one among the few centers that provide free evaluation and laser treatment for retinal diseases like diabetic retinopathy and retinopathy of prematurity. It is attached to Madras Medical College and with an annual intake on 30 Post Graduates per year and also serves as a training and research centre for various categories of Medical Students.

2. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has furnished the particulars regarding the General and Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme performance, HR details about the Regional Institute of Ophthalmology and given the Justification to the requirement of equipments to the institution at a cost of Rs.8,00,90,000/-

3. The State Empowered Committee has approved the above proposal.

4. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has requested the Government to issue the orders in this regard.

5. The Government after careful consideration on the request of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program have decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders:-

- i. Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.8,00,90,000/- (Rupees Eight Crore and Ninety Thousand Only) towards the Procurement of Vision Saving High End Ophthalmic Equipments through Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited for the Newly Built Bi Centenary Block at Regional Institute of Ophthalmology, Chennai.
- ii. The Director of Medical Education is authorized to draw and deposit the above sanctioned amount in the Personal Deposit Account of TNMSC to the procurement of the required equipments (as annexed in this order).
- iii. A separate account to be maintained exclusively for Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program funds in Directorates and facilities involved which should be operated by joint signatory.

6. For the expenditure of purchase of equipment sanctioned in para 5(i) above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

2210 – Medical and Public Health – 01 Urban Health Services – Allopathy – 110 Hospitals and Dispensaries – Externally Aided Project – PE – Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Project – Administrated by the Director of Medical Education – 319 Machinery and Equipments – 01 Purchase.

7. Necessary funds of Rs.8,00,90,000/- will be provided in Final Modified Appropriation 2022 – 2023. Pending provision of such funds, the Director of Medical Education is authorized to draw and disburse the above sanctioned amount. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023. The Director of Medical Education is also requested to include this expenditure while sending the budget proposals for Final Modified Appropriation 2022 - 2023 and also send draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023 to Government in Finance (BG-I/ Health-II) Department at an appropriate time without fail.
