ORDER:

The Hon'ble Minister for Health and Family Welfare has made the following Announcement in the floor of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly during the Demand No.19.

Announcement No.20:-

"நீலகிரி அரசு மருத்துவக் கல்லூரி மருத்துவமனைக்கு உலக வங்கி திட்டத்தின்கீழ் ரூபாய் 50 இலட்சம் மதிப்பீட்டில் நடமாடும் இரத்த சேமிப்பு வாகணம், HPLC கருவி மற்றும் வேதியியல் பொருட்கள் வழங்கப்படும்".

- 2. Based on the above announcement, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has sent a letter read above along with the justification, vital statistics and general performance of the Medical College Hospitai, Udhagamandalam, The Nilgiris District and requested to provide the Mobile Blood Collection Van to that hospital.
- 3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has worked out the cost involved in the above activity and furnished as follows:-

- 4. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has stated that the above proposal had been approved by the State Empowered Committee and not included in PIP 2022-2023 Budget of NHM-Tamil Nadu and hence requested the Government to issue the necessary orders in this regard.
- 5. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program have decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders:-
 - (i) Sanction is accorded for a sum of non-recurring amount of Rs.30,00,000/- (Rupees thirty lakhs only) towards the provision of Mobile Blood Collection transport Van (MBCTV) to the Government Medical College Hospital, Udhagamandalam, The Nilgiris District.
 - (ii) The Director of Medical Education is authorized to draw and disburse the above sanctioned amount to Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited and handed over the registered MBCTV to Tamil Nadu State AIDS Control Society (TANSACS) for effective operationalization.
 - (iii) The Directorate of Medical Education is approved to send necessary proposals to National Health Mission, Tamil Nadu to meet out the recurring expenditure / operational cost (i.e. hiring of services of Driver cum Cleaner and Fuel for the vehicle) under the Blood Services component
 - (iv) A separate Savings Bank Account to be maintained exclusively for Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program funds in Directorate and facilities involved which should be operationalized by Joint Account (Dean & Blood Bank Medical Officer).
- 6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 (i) above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

2210 – Medical and Public Health – 01 Urban Health Services - Allopathy – 110 Hospitals and Dispensaries – Externally Aided Project - PE – Tamil Nadu Health System Reforms Project – Administrated by the Director of Medical Education – 321 - Motor Vehicles - 01 Purchase.

7. Necessary additional funds of Rs.30,00,000/- will be provided in RE / FMA 2022-2023. Pending provision of such funds, the Director of Medical Education is authorized to draw and disburse the sanctioned amount in para 5 above. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the legislature by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023. The Director of Medical Education is also requested to include this expenditure while sending the budget proposals for RE/FMA 2022-2023 and also send draft explanatory notes for specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023 to Government in Finance (BG-I / Health-II) Department at an appropriate time without fail.
