ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have issued orders for Capacity building and Quality enhanced training of all Health care Cadres titled "Tamil Nadu Quality Enhanced Structured Training" (TAN-QuEST) and approved and adopted the Strategy as annexed thereon.

2. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program in her letter read above has stated that, this program involves organized, monitored and performance assessed training on specific areas of the health services in tertiary, secondary and primary care based on the needs assessment of the gaps in knowledge, skills and attitudes of the health-care professionals in delivering quality health care services to the population. The disbursement already claimed by the Government for this activity is Rs.21.00 Crore and final disbursement claim for the TAN-QuEST implementation is Rs.38.00 Crore.

3 The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has further stated that during the process of re-structuring by the World Bank, the preparation of operational plan & piloting of TAN-QuEST at Tirunelveli Medical College & Hospital was added as one of the macro level intervention in Quality of care strategy activity which entitles a claim of 5 million USD. (Rs.38.00 Crore). This program is proposed as two phases based on existing resources of the system and leveraging on its strengths.

Phase 1 (2022-2023): Preparation of Modules & Creation of Web portal

Phase 2 (2023-2024): Pilot Training & roll out at a selected Medical College

4. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has furnished the expenditure proposed for the year 2023 is as follows:-

5. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has stated that the State Empowered Committee had approved the above proposal and requested the Government to issue necessary orders in this regard.

6. After careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program, the Government have decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders:-

- Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.81,00,000/- (Rupees Eighty one lakhs only) towards the creation of TAN-QuEST online training portal in collaboration with NIC and to release the fund to NIC (actuals) and strengthening of Medical Education unit.
- Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten lakh only) towards administrative expenditure for preparation of courses, modules and study material regarding the piloting of TAN-QuEST.
- The Director of Medical Education is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned at para 6 (i) above.

- (iv) The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned at para 6(ii) above.
- (v) A separate account to be maintained exclusively for Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program funds in the Directorate of Medical Education and facilities involved which should be operated by the joint signatory.

7. The expenditure is sanctioned in para 6 (i) above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

2210 – Medical and Public Health – 01 Urban Health Services - Allopathy – 110 Hospitals and Dispensaries – Externally Aided Project – PE – Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Project – Administred by Director of Medical Education – 309 Grants-in-Aid – 03 Grants for Specific Schemes.
