## ORDER:

In Government order first read above, orders were issued to establish an Emergency Department in 25 Medical College Hospitals with dedicated faculties by create one post of Professor, one post of Associate Professor, one post of Assistant Professor and one post of Emergency Department Secretary for each Medical College Hospitals at a recurring cost of Rs.10.97 crore during the year 2020-2021. In addition that, one post of Associate Professor and one post of Assistant Professor to the Government Royapettah Hospital, one post of Assistant Professor for Institute of Child Health, Egmore was sanctioned and thus the component of the post creation is sanctioned as follows:-

2. In Government order second and third read above, orders were issued for sanction of the recurring cost towards the salary component of the filled up posts for the subsequent years.

In continuation on the above, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program in her letter fourth read above, has proposed for the recurring cost towards the salary component of the above said posts sanctioned towards the Establishment of Emergency Department with dedicated faculties at 25 Government Medical College Hospitals and 2 attached institutions for the year – 5 (2023 – 2024) as follows:-

- 4. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has further stated that the State Empowered Committee headed by the Chief Secretary had approved the above proposal and hence requested the Government to issue the necessary orders in this regard.
- 5. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program have decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders:-
  - Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.19,40,75,352/- (Rupees Nineteen crore forty lakh seventy five thousand three hundred and fifty two only) towards the recurring cost of Establishment of Emergency Department at 25 Government Medical College Hospitals and 2 attached institutions as annexed to this order.
  - ii. The Director of Medical Education and Research is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned at para 5(i) above.
  - iii. Out of the amount sanctioned at para 5(i) above, Rs.18,80,90,352/- (Rupees Eighteen crore eighty lakh ninety thousand three hundred and fifty two only) shall be debited from the following head of account:-
