ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the guidelines for conducting District and State Health Assembly were adopted. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic lockdown, the proposed health assemblies were conducted subsequently and orders were issued accordingly in the other Government Orders read above.

2. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program in her letter read above, has stated that one of the Disbursement Linked Indicators (DLIs) of Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program (TNHSRP) is the Increased Transparency and Accountability through Citizen Engagement (DLI 8) by conducting District Health Assembly and State Health Assembly. Accordingly it is proposed to conduct of Health Assemblies in 24 Districts and 1 State Health Assembly for the year 2023-2024 and furnished the details of the District Health Assembly conducted as follows:-.

3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has further stated that the State Empowered Committee had approved the proposal and hence requested the Government to issue orders in this regard.

4. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program have decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders:-

- i. Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.1,46,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore Forty Six Lakhs only) to the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program so as to conduct the District Health Assemblies in 24 districts (Thirupathur, Ranipet, Kallakurichi, Chengalpattu, Mayiladuthurai, Perambalur, Nagapattinam, Chennai (North Zone), Chennai (Central Zone), Chennai (South Zone),Theni, Tiruvannamalai, Virudhunagar, Tirunelveli, Ramanathapuram, Salem, Cuddalore, Madurai, Coimbatore, Namakkal, Villupuram, Krishnagiri, Dindigul, Tiruvallur) in the year 2023-2024.
- ii. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program is authorized to draw and disburse the fund to Directorates / District Health Societies concerned to conduct the Health Assemblies for the year 2023-2024.
- iii. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program is authorized to conduct the Health Assemblies through the District Health Societies concerned with the support of the Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine, Directorate of Medical and Rural Health Services, Directorate of Medical Education and Research and District Health Societies concerned.
- iv. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reforms Program is permitted to conduct State Health Assembly after completing 24 District Health Assemblies and submit the consolidated report of DHA and SHA to World Bank for claiming the disbursement of Rs.22.64 Crore for the year 2023-2024.

5. The expenditure sanction is para 4(i) above shall be debited to the following head of account:-
