ORDER:

The Hon'ble Minister for Health and Family Welfare has made the following Announcement in the floor of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly during the Demand No.19.

Announcement No.13:-

2. Based on the above announcement, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has sent a letter read above along with the vital statistics and general performance relates of the Government Hospital, Kalakkadu and requested to establish a Poison Management Center at Government Hospital, Kalakkadu, Tirunelveli District and furnished the estimated budget for the activity which is to be undertaken during the year 2022-2023 as follows:stimated Budget

- 3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has further stated that the State Empowered Committee had approved the above said proposal and requested the Government to issue the necessary orders in this regard.
- 4. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program have decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders:-
 - (i) Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.26,40,000/-(Rupees Twenty Six Lakhs Forty Thousand only) towards the construction of the building towards the establishment of Poison Management Center at Government Hospital, Kalakkadu, Tirunelveli District through the PWD (Medical) Wing.
 - (ii) Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.13,60,000/- (Rupees Thirteen Lakhs Sixty Thousand only) towards the Procurement of required Equipment to the above said hospital through Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Ltd.
 - (iii) The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned at para 4 (i) and (ii) above
 - (iv) A separate SB account to be maintained exclusively for Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program funds in the Directorate of Medical and Rural Health Services and facilities involved which should be operated by the joint signatory.
- 5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 (i) and (ii) above shall be debited to the following head of account respectively:-

2210-Medical and Public Health-01 Urban Health Services – Allopathy – 110 Hospitals and Dispensaries – Externally Aided Projects - PD, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Reforms Project – Administrated by the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services-317 Minor Works - 01 Minor Works.

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.40,00,000/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2022 – 2023. Pending provision of such funds in RE/FMA 2022 – 2023, the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is authorized to draw and disburse the above sanctioned amount. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023.

The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is also requested to include this expenditure while sending the budget proposals for RE/FMA 2022 - 2023 and also send necessary draft explanatory notes for specific inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023 to Government in Finance (BG-I/Health-I) Department at an appropriate time without fail.
